## ABOUT THE STUDIO

We are an educational institution and provide a full program of classes in varied disciplines for all ages and levels. The students will enjoy the two bright studios with sprung floors, mirrors and barres to create a "dance" atmosphere. Ample watching and waiting areas for parents, change rooms, lockers, washrooms, kitchen, office and a dancewear boutique are here for your convenience.

### WEE DANCE

A half day program for two to four year old children. This morning program will include dance, music appreciation, crafts & games. A perfect way to introduce dance and the arts to the stars of tomorrow.

### DANCE EXTENSIONS

A special program offering a variety of courses, takes place during the month of June. This is an excellent chance for students to enroll in a dance subject for a short term.

### LET'S DANCE

Summer Day Camp for Junior & Intermediate dancers ages 4 & up is held in August and features "all day dance" with a variety of disciplines- always fun! A week long competitive camp in August will feature guest teachers for Performers & Intermediate/Senior Level Dancers.

### CHRISTMAS SPIRIT

Shows are performed in November and December. Many of the classes participate and entertain at various local events.

### PERFORMERS YOUTH DANCE COMPANY

Dancers from 7 years and up may audition in June/July if they are experienced in a variety of dance disciplines. This is an excellent opportunity for talented dancers to gain performing experience in a competitive scene. This group annually presents the "Spotlight" Show which features all competitive dancers from the studio, and participates in dance competitions throughout the North American circuit.

### ADULT COMPETITIVE TEAM

A fun experience for adults who love dance and would like to try competition. Rehearsals are 1 hour weekly. No competitive experience required.

### EXAMS

C.D.T.A. syllabus is used to train the ballet and tap students in correct technique. Exams may be taken at the end of the season if the student has reached the required level.

### DANCE RECITAL

This full costume production held annually at the Capitol Centre features all students. This year the show will take place on the last Sunday in May at 1PM. Tickets are reserved seating and go on sale May 1st at the Capitol Centre Box office. Dress Rehearsal and Photos of all group classes takes place during the week prior.

### DROP IN DANCE ENRICHMENT

Technique classes for Junior & Intermediate & Senior dancers Ages 9 & up during July. A great way to stay in "dance shape" and improve technical skills during summer break.
